HOW DID BROADLANDS SAC RAISE FUNDS IN 2019/2020?

In 2019/2020, the following fundraising initiatives helped bring in a net total of \$10,795. There was a carry-over of \$11,419 from the 2018-2019 school year.

- Pizza/Hot Lunches/Milk \$7535
- Annual Voluntary Contribution \$3260

WHAT ACTIVITIES DID SAC FINANCIALLY SUPPORT OR EXECUTE?

1. Enrichment initiatives in Science, Music, Drama, Sports, Technology, and Clubs

- STEM Equipment \$5,104.00
- Recess Carts (With toys and other recess sports equipment) \$1,649.00
- Music/Drama Risers \$2,800.00
- Prologue (Drama) workshops \$2,068.00
- Water Bottle Refill Station \$2,700.00

2. Community Building

- For graduating students, presented \$200 in cash awards and helped fund graduation activities
- Free babysitting at SAC-sponsored events
